Silence is kept.

We join together in saying the words of an opening prayer.

Let us pray. Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful people, and kindle in us the fire of your love; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Introduction to Confession

Jesus says, 'Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is close at hand.' So let us turn away from sin and turn to the Lord, confessing our sins in penitence and faith.

Praise and Thanksgiving

A song of praise may be listened to or a psalm may be read. People may be invited to speak out prayers of praise and thanksgiving.

There may also be a brief introduction to the theme.



Readings

We hear readings from the Bible. After each reading the reader says Holy wisdom, hold word.

We all respond Thanks be to God.

Reflection

A few thoughts are shared on one or more of the Bible readings. This may take the form of a reflection, a discussion or a Bible study.

A hymn or a worship song may be played to bring the reflection to an end and to help us to begin to respond.

Do you believe and trust in God the Father, source of all being and life, the one for whom we exist? **We believe and trust in him.**

Do you believe and trust in God the Son, who took our human nature, died for us and rose again? We believe and trust in him.

This is the faith of the Church. This is our faith. We believe and trust in one God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Amen.
