

It's great to finally be here at St James' & St Nicolas Churches and start to be get to know you a little - please do continue to be patient if I need to keep asking your names!

Last newsletter I talked about September being all about new starts for me but September 2022 will be remembered as the time that we as a nation (and indeed many across the world) mourned the death of Her Majesty the Queen. During this time we had the churches open for private prayer and signing the book of condolence - it was very moving to see people, some who have little connection with the church come in and spend a few quiet moments in prayer before lighting a candle or writing a message of condolence or in tribute. It was powerful to see so many wait patiently and respectfully in line to pay their respects to Her Majesty as she was laid in state. Many people said how 'lost' they felt now she was gone.

But what a moving and inspiring day the day of the funeral was - with the large and respectful processions, the evocative music and the funeral service itself: The Archbishop of Canterbury delivering a powerful and hope-filled message that picked up the tone of the whole service - of the life of a person of duty and loyal service who was energised and inspired by her faith and hope in Jesus - her king and shepherd. One of the most powerful moments in the service for me was the singing of the Hymn 'Love Divine'. The final words of the song resonated with Christian-resurrection-hope in the Abbey packed with dignitaries, world leaders and mourners watched by nearly half the world's population:



Finish, then, thy new creation;
true and spotless let us be.
Let us see thy great salvation
perfectly restored in thee.
Changed from glory into glory,
till in heav'n we take our place,
till we cast our crowns before thee,
lost in wonder, love and praise.



I pray that this month that whatever comes along for you, however lost you may feel, that hope of eternity with Christ 'lost in wonder, love and praise' may sustain and encourage you as it clearly did for Her Majesty the late Queen Flizabeth.

Operation Christmas Child (OCC)

Once again, this year we will be supporting OCC.

I would like to thank you for packing shoebox gifts previously.

A simple heartfelt gift, packed with love and fuelled by prayer can mean so much to a child in need.

Will you pack a shoebox again, or even for the first time, to share God's love with even more boys and girls this season?

This year the OCC goal is to send two-thirds of shoeboxes from the UK to Ukraine or the neighbouring countries like Moldova and Romania that are hosting many Ukrainian refugee families.
