Welcome to the Summer Newsletter



The Summer, with the warmer weather (we hope) and longer days gives chance for more recreation and outdoor leisure: a time for H holidays. The name and concept of 'Holiday' originated as the 'Holy Days' and festivals of the church created space and time for rest from work.

The patterns of busyness of and rest from work are a continual battle not just for those who are in full time paid work but also, and perhaps more so, those who are 'retired'. At our Youth Alpha Group, which started at the end of June, we talked about what we might do if we had 24 hours available and money and travel time were unlimited. A lot of answers seemed to be about travel, holidays and resting. Our lives, even for some of our youngest can feel pretty busy and pressured. Whether you take the summer time or find it some other time of the year, I pray you may find some time to rest. But rest is not just about the absence of work. Augustine famously said "Our hearts are restless until they find their rest in [God] ". Jesus said, "come to me all who are heavy laden and I will give you rest" (Matt 11:28) and our Bibles begin with Genesis 2 reminding us that on the seventh day God rested - what rest does our omnipotent, all powerful God need? Rest is enabled by the absence of work and the opportunity for physical, mental and spiritual recovery but it is about re-orientating and recalibrating ourselves as a created and redeemed people with our Creator-God. I love the first question and answer of the Westminster Shorter Catechism:

Q: What is the Chief end of man? [ie. what is the purpose of humanity] A: The chief end of man is to worship God, and to enjoy him forever.

That's great isn't it!? That to truly rest, and to truly work, is to enjoy God forever. I pray that over this summer time you may find time to rest, and in resting enjoy God's presence and experience His Holy-Day


Small donations making a big impact

Are you finding things tough at the moment? Every Friday morning we have food hampers available.

What will I get?

Each hamper will contain a selection of frozen, fresh and food cupboard items. There should be enough for a few meals, depending on how many are within your household. For households of over 4 people, please book two hamper tickets.

Who are the hampers for?

Anyone who is in need can book a hamper. The idea is that the hamper will provide a boost to your food shopping for the week, rather than providing a full week of food.

How do I book?

Hampers can only be booked on the week for the collection day that week, which is always a Friday. Tickets will be released at the beginning of the week. To book simply pick a free 'Food Hamper' ticket, put in your details and checkout.

How do I get my hamper?

Once you have booked, just come into Saints Cafe (on Newdegate St) on the Friday between 10am-12pm to collect your hamper
