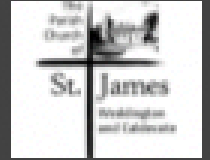

Have you thought of being Confirmed?

Confirmation is a special church service in which a person confirms the promises that were made when they were baptized. If you were baptized at a christening when you were a child, your parents and godparents made these promises on your behalf. As a young person or adult, you may be ready to affirm these promises for yourself and commit your life to following Jesus Christ. At a confirmation service, you make these promises for yourself. Your friends and family as well as the local Christian community will be there to promise to support and pray for you.

The local bishop will lay their hands on your head and ask God's Holy Spirit to give you the strength and commitment to live God's way for the rest of your life.

St Nicolas Bells: Damage to our 5th Bell

It has recently been confirmed to us by Andrew Alldrick of the Coventry Guild of Bell Ringers & John Taylor Bell Founders that severe damage has occurred to the 5th bell. The main problem is the wheel – side gudgeon pin and the cast iron housing which have sheared off therefore the bell(s) in their current state cannot be rung.

The PCC have now agreed to the work to be carried out to the tune of £11,000 which includes the removal of all bell parts to the foundry in Loughborough and the checking and cleaning of the bearings of all remaining bells in order to preserve them for future generations.

Grants have been applied for to help us with the overall costs, but should you be able to make a donation to our 'Bell Fund' we would appreciate it very much. This can be done by speaking to Jim (our Treasurer) who will guide you in the ways to make a payment.

A full report of the current condition of the bells from John Taylor & Co is available from the Churchwardens. Should you be able to assist with the removal / reinstallation of the bell parts please contact Garry & Nick as we shall be offered a discount on the final invoice for any labour we can give them. We will keep you updated as the work progresses.
